CLINICAL

- 1. Ability to engage Latino/a/x individuals, families, and groups
- 2. Ability to describe the impact of immigration, migration, sociopolitical and cultural factors on Latinos
- 3. Ability to apply culturally relevant social work interventions with Latino/a/x individuals, families, and groups
- 4. Ability to practice self-awareness in managing the influence of personal biases when working with Latino/a/x clients
- 5. Ability to acknowledge the client to be the expert of their own lived experience

MAP

- 1. Ability to design and administer programs, projects, and services within a cultural context
- 2. Ability to describe the impact of immigration, migration, sociopolitical and cultural factors on Latinos
- 3. Ability to engage Latino/a/x communities and form alliances with interested groups for purposes of advocacy of Latino/a/x issues and advancing common interests
- 4. Ability to understand and stay current with local and national policies affecting Latino/a/x communities and families as well as disseminate appropriate information regarding public policies, public health news, etc.
